I'm feelin' the strain, Ain't it a shame? Oh

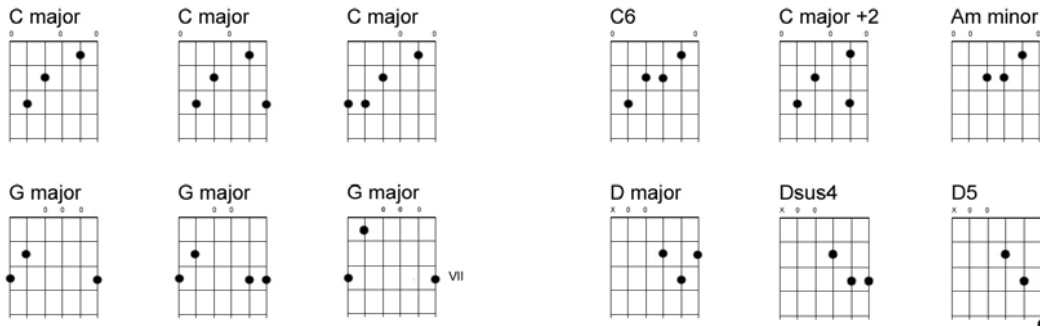
Beginnin' to think that I'm wastin' time
