

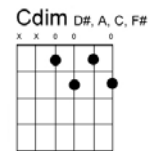
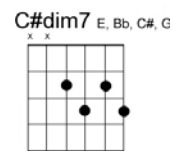
# Give My Love to Rose by Johnny Cash (4/4 time, A major on the recording)
