4/4 time (four beats or strums per chord)—use Travis picking

Play Travis picking on all four-beat chords.

Together they would travel, on a boat with billowed sail  
Jackie kept a lookout perched on Puff's gigantic tail  
Noble kings and princes, would bow whenever they came  
Pirate ships would lower their flag when Puff roared out her name

A dragon lives forever, but not so little girls  
Painted rings and giant rings made way for other pearls  
One grey night it happened, Jackie Paper came no more,  
And Puff hat mighty dragon sadly ceased her fearful roar

Play bass (root note) and down stroke strum on where four beats are split into two chords.

Her head was bent in sorrow, green scales fell like rain
